Volunteers in clinical roles

work directly with hospital leadership and clinical staff on health service delivery, capacity building, and various outreach projects within the community setting to reach those who lack access to healthcare.

Volunteer Abroad

Long-term clinical service & health administration

Who: Doctors, nurses, and other licensed healthcare professionals, public health experts, communications specialists, supply chain managers, therapists and more

Where: Haiti, Kenya, Peru, South Sudan, and Zambia

How long: Six months to one year

Short-term – residency, medical mission trips, clinical service & mentoring, telemedicine

Who: Third & fourth year medical students, licensed healthcare professionals, highly skilled public health professionals

Where: Kenya, Peru, Zambia, Haiti or working remotely

How long: One week to six months

Volunteer at home

NYC Internships

Interns support all CMMB departments as well as our five country offices while building skills and experience for careers in global health and development.

Who: Graduate and undergraduate students, young professionals

How long: One month to a year
