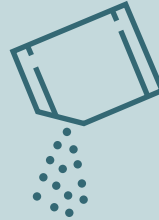

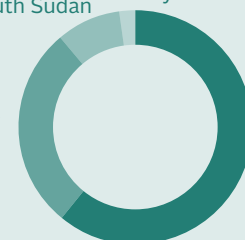

children under one-year-old were fully immunized.

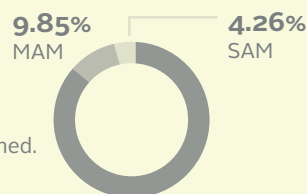
