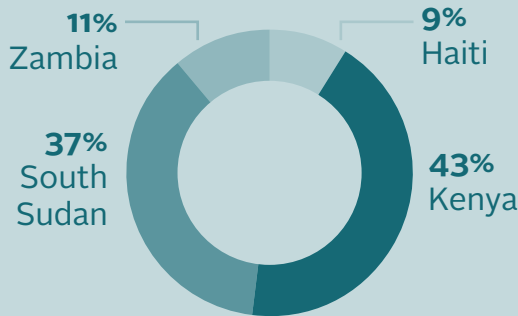


## Water and Sanitation

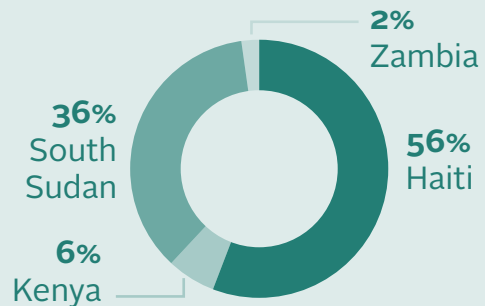

vitamin A supplements.



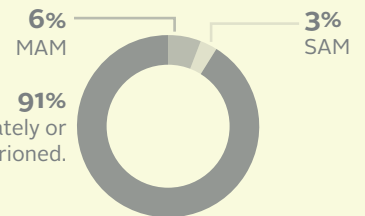
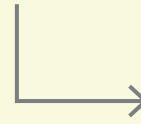
**31,621**
