Our CHAMPS program (Children and Mothers Partnerships) creates lasting change in the care, and lives, of vulnerable women and children.

CMMB invests in: providing antenatal care and safe delivery services to pregnant mothers; preventing and treating major health threats to children, like malaria and diarrhea, and combating malnutrition; ensuring childhood immunizations; and expanding access to clean water and good sanitation.

Women who never could have sought care now travel for miles so that they can give birth in a safe, clean environment and feel the expression of dignity that every person deserves.
